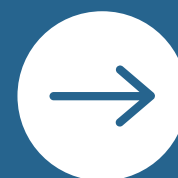




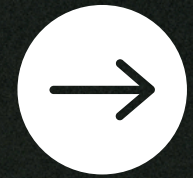

Camera Modes



Gives you full control over settings like ISO, aperture, and shutter speed. Experiment with it to achieve more creative shots.

Exposure Triangle



Understand who you're trying to reach with your content, such as their needs, interests and preferences

Focus on Composition



Create a content plan that outlines the type of content you'll create, how often it will be shared, and where it will be distributed.

Lighting is Key



Midday sunlight can create harsh shadows. If shooting at this time, look for shade or use a diffuser.

Camera Steady
